Key elements of this role you could expect to undertake or be asked to do:	You will maintain the safety of the works of art on display and the visitors within the space, providing excellent customer service within the exhibition. You'll be answering questions and helping visitors to interpret the images on display. You will efficiently and courteously direct enquiries regarding purchases of works on display and process sales of merchandise.
You will be working with:	You will be working alongside other Exhibition Volunteers and Gallery Assistants within the Stables Coach House spaces.

- An interest and enthusiasm for Waddesdon and the work of the National Trust
- Approachable, friendly, well presented with confident interpersonal and communication skills
- Outgoing, enthusiastic and positive with a passion for fantastic visitor care and reliable with good time keeping
- Confidence with using electronic tablets and devices
- Enjoys working as part of a team
- Previous experience of working with the public would be useful

Anticipated Time Contribution:	1/2 day a fortnight from Wednesday to Sunday. Two shifts daily, 11am- 2.30pm & 2pm-5pm.
Lunch breaks and comfort breaks:	Lunch breaks and comfort breaks will be factored into your day.
