DOMAINES BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE

AT THE HEART OF THE DOMAINES BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE GROUP LIES THE ILLUSTRIOUS CHÂTEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD. THE FIRST CHÂTEAU PURCHASED BY THE FRENCH ARM OF THE ROTHSCHILD FAMILY, LAFITE HAS CULTIVATED A TRADITION OF WINEGROWING PRACTICES AND EXPERTISE OVER SIX GENERATIONS. NAMED THE 'LAFITE SPIRIT', THIS HAS CONTINUED TO GUIDE THE PRODUCTION OF HIGH QUALITY WINES WITH FINESSE AND ELEGANCE THROUGHOUT THE GROUP'S PROPERTIES OVER THE PAST CENTURY AND A HALF.

It is this pioneering 'Lafite Spirit', based on a rich past and tradition rooted in the soils of Bordeaux, that has led the Group to open up to the world, establishing vineyards in new regions and producing new, high quality wines. The handing down of knowledge from generation to generation persists to the present day, with the most recent succession occurring in 2018 when Saskia de Rothschild became the 6th generation to take up the reins of Château Lafite and Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite. Beyond the Bordeaux properties of Château Duhart-Milon, Château Rieussec and Château L'Evangile, the Group today also counts the prestigious wineries of Viña Los Vascos (Chile, 1988), Domaine d'Aussières (Languedoc, 1999), Bodegas Caro (Argentina, 1999) and a new vineyard in China, Domaine de Long Dai, among its collection. With a total 1,200 hectares of vineyards, Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite works with an international network of more than 80 distributors.





OWNER OF CHÂTEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD FOR FIVE GENERATIONS, THE ROTHSCHILD FAMILY HAS BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH THE VINEYARDS OF BORDEAUX SINCE 1868 AND TODAY OWNS CHÂTEAUX LAFITE ROTHSCHILD, DUHART MILON, L'ÉVANGILE AND RIEUSSEC.

In addition to the wines produced from their prestigious vineyards, the Barons de Rothschild have for many years created a range of more accessible wines for everyday drinking. Initially created at the request of family and friends, these were known as the "Réserves des Barons". In a continuation of this tradition, Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite decided to produce the Réserves in four major Bordeaux appellations: Bordeaux, Bordeaux Blanc, Médoc and Pauillac. In creating the Collection, DBR Lafite's objective is to offer classic Bordeaux wines with immediate charm.

A major appellation in the Médoc, Pauillac benefits from an exceptional terroir characterized by gravelly hilltops on a clay subsoil which ensures natural drainage and encourages the vines to develop deep roots: these are the perfect conditions for Cabernet Sauvignon.





Légende Pauillac6 x 75cl

With Cabernet and Merlot grapes taken from the vineyards of Lafite and Duhart Milon, this Pauillac is widely considered to be the 'unofficial third wine of Lafite'.

Légende Médoc6 x 75cl

A blend of Cabernet and Merlot with gentle oak ageing to provide a smooth and layered expression of Bordeaux's most famous left bank region.

An approachable blend of Cabernet and Merlot with a fruit forward style, while remaining honest to the style of the region.







IT WAS AT THE URGING OF CHÂTEAU LAFITE'S OWNERS IN THE EARLY 18TH CENTURY THAT WIDESPREAD GRAPE CULTIVATION IN THE PAUILLAC DISTRICT BEGAN. JUST NEXT DOOR, THE PRESTIGIOUS FOURTH GROWTH OF CHÂTEAU DUHART MILON BECAME LAFITE'S SECOND PAUILLAC PROPERTY.

The Château's soils have long been recognised for their high quality and its wine was ranked as a Fourth Growth in Pauillac in 1855. However, successive changes in ownership led the estate's vineyards to decline dramatically, and it was only four decades after the Rothschild family acquired it in 1962 that the property saw its prestigious classification restored.

Moulin de Duhart is the second wine of the stunning Duhart-Milon estate, which lies just to the west of Château Lafite's Carruades vineyards. The same technical team, first class facilities and attention to detail are employed in the production of this wine as they are to the first wine of the estate. **Moulin de Duhart 6 x 75cl** This classic Cabernet and Merlot blend shows all the characteristics of a fine Pauillac. Wonderful depth and richness, well structured with precise layers of dark berry fruits and flinty tannins.







THROUGH A MYSTERY OF GEOLOGY, THE SOUTHEAST POMEROL PLATEAU FEATURES A LONG LINE OF SURFACE GRAVEL. THREE VINEYARDS, INCLUDING CHÂTEAU L'ÉVANGILE, SHARE THIS RARE SOIL.

The property is bordered to the north by Château Pétrus and separated from Château Cheval Blanc in Saint-Émilion to the south by nothing more than a secondary road.

The vineyard covers 22 hectares, made up of sandy clay soil with pure gravel, on a subsoil containing iron residues. The grape varieties consist of Merlot (80%) which contributes to the wine's fruity flavour, body and its unmistakable suppleness; and 'Bouchet', the local name for Cabernet Franc (20%), which brings finesse and structure.

Château L'Évangile was acquired by Domaines Barons de Rothschild in 1990 from the Ducasse family. Blason de L'Évangile, the estate's second wine, has characteristics similar to the Grand vin, but less potential for ageing as it is matured in barrels for a shorter period of time. It should be enjoyed younger than its more robust counterpart.

With the elegance of the first wine of the estate, this classic Merlot blend delivers black cherries, dark chocolate and perfectly precise tannins. Drink now or keep for 5+ years.





CHÂTEAU PARADIS CASSEUIL



CHÂTEAU PARADIS CASSEUIL TAKES ITS NAME FROM TWO SOURCES. CASSEUIL IS THE NAME OF THE DISTRICT, WHILST PARADIS COMES FROM THE LAND REGISTRY WHERE THE MAIN PARCEL OF VINES ON THE PROPERTY IS KNOWN AS "LES VIGNES DU PARADIS" – THE VINES OF PARADISE.

Château Paradis Casseuil formerly belonged to Château Rieussec. When purchasing the First Growth of Sauternes in 1984, Baron Eric de Rothschild lost no time in adding this jewel of the Entre-Deux-Mers region to the DBR portfolio. The vineyard of Paradis Casseuil was extended in 1989, becoming one of the leading properties of the region. **Château Paradis Casseuil 6 x 75cl** A modern and fresh blend of Merlot and

Cabernet Sauvignon with a little oak and an easy drinking Bordeaux style.







PREVIOUSLY NAMED CHÂTEAU PEYRE-LEBADE BASED ON ITS GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION, THE ESTATE WAS RENAMED CHÂTEAU ODILON, IN HONOUR OF PAINTER ODILON REDON WHO SPENT HIS CHILDHOOD AND MOST OF HIS WORKING LIFE ON THE PROPERTY. HIS MOST FAMOUS PAINTINGS WERE INSPIRED BY THE BUCOLIC LANDSCAPES OF THE MÉDOC, SCATTERED WITH MOOR AND MARSHLANDS.

In 1979, after being neglected for several years, the property was acquired by Baron Edmond de Rothschild who already owned the neighbouring estates: Châteaux Clarke and Malmaison. This acquisition marked the beginning of a new era, starting with the complete restructuring of the vineyards and restoration of the buildings.

The 55 hectares of the estate are planted with Cabernet Sauvignon (24%), Merlot (64%), and Cabernet Franc (12%). The limestone-rich geology of the site certainly influenced the original name of the property, since Peyre-Lebade means 'raised rock' (pierre levée).

Château Odilon6 x 75cl Château Odilon has the fruity and fleshy style so characteristic of Haut-Médoc wines. Its high Merlot content contributes to its unique, supple style.







THE FIRST GROWTH SAUTERNES PROPERTY OF CHÂTEAU RIEUSSEC WAS ACQUIRED BY DOMAINES BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE IN 1984. THE ESTATE THEN CONSISTED OF 110 HECTARES, 68 HECTARES OF WHICH WERE VINES. TO ENHANCE CHÂTEAU RIEUSSEC'S POTENTIAL, RIGOROUS MEASURES WERE IMPLEMENTED, INCLUDING METICULOUS SORTING OF THE GRAPES AND FERMENTING IN BARRELS, WHICH PROVIDED A MUCH FINER SELECTION FOR THE BLENDING OF THE GRAND VIN.

Today, Château Rieussec's vineyard extends to the border of Fargues and Sauternes and adjoins Château d'Yquem. Rieussec is one of the largest properties in Sauternes and Barsac, with the vineyard covering 93 hectares of gravelly sandy-clay soil.

In addition to the iconic botrytis wines produced at Rieussec, a dry expression of the grapes is produced. R de Rieussec brings the same Sauvignon and Sémillon blend together but with a vibrant dry style suited to every occasion. Partly produced from the same vines as the Sauternes, 20% of fermentation takes place in barrels which enhances the wine's potential to age, while preserving its freshness and the natural fruitiness from the grapes. 





AUSSIÈRES HAS MADE WINE SINCE THE ROMAN ERA, A PERIOD WHEN THE GREAT PROPERTIES OF THE "ROMAN PROVINCE OF NARBONNE" WERE RECORDED IN THE LAND REGISTRY AND BECAME THE MAIN WINE SUPPLIERS TO ROME.

Acquired in 1999 by Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite, the 550-hectare Domaine d'Aussières underwent a vast rehabilitation programme to restore and revitalize one of the oldest and most beautiful wine-making properties in the Narbonne region.

167 hectares of vines were replanted with carefully selected traditional Languedoc grape varieties: Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre and Carignan, complemented by Cabernet, Merlot and Chardonnay. The estate buildings were restored at the same time and a new winery installed in the old cellars, in the heart of the vineyard. Two thirds of the vineyard fall in the Corbières AOC appellation and one third in the Vin de Pays d'Oc appellation. The consistency and remarkable potential of the wines produced since 2003 have already positioned Aussières as one of the front runners in the revival of the Languedoc.

Domaines Barons De Rothschild Lafite took over Los Vascos (meaning the Basques, in honour of its Basque origins) in 1988. At the time, the estate extended to 2,200 hectares with 220 hectares planted to vine.

Planted in a single block, the vineyard at Viña Los Vascos benefits from intense exposure to the sun, adequate water sources, semiarid soils and little risk of frost. This unique microclimate has everything needed to produce extraordinary wines and a mixture of grape varietals thrive here: Cabernet Sauvignon (85%), Carmenère (5%), Syrah (4%), Malbec (1%) and Chardonnay (5%). Following a major replanting at the beginning of the 1990s, the vineyard is divided between a group of 15-year old plots and another group of 40 to 50-year old plots. The oldest vines are 70 years old.





VIÑA LOS VASCOS

Le Dix de Los Vascos**6 x 75cl** The first wine of the estate, a velvety blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Carménère & Syrah sourced from only the best plots, with 18 months of oak ageing. Presented individually wrapped in laying wooden 6 pack cases.

Los Vascos Grande Réserve**12 x 75cl** A Cabernet Sauvignon blend with 12 months of oak ageing. Dark berry fruits with black pepper and toasted walnuts.

Los Vascos Carménère Grande Réserve12 x 75cl A vibrant 100% Carménère with 12 months of oak ageing. Inky, with dark chocolate, brambles and the lovely mint notes of Chile's native grape.

Los Vascos Cromas Carménère Gran Reserva12 x 75cl

The beautifully relaunched Los Vascos Grande Reserve, Cromas Carménère Gran Reserva now reflects the unique red hues of the Andes mountains and the ultramarine ocean breathing life into the vineyards. Los Vascos Chardonnay12 x 75cl A light, unoaked Chardonnay with tropical fruit and citrus notes. Lees aging provides great length and a smooth and rounded mouthfeel. Los Vascos Sauvignon Blanc12 x 75cl A bright and vibrant Sauvignon Blanc with perfect acidity. Gooseberry, lychee and peach notes are complemented with asparagus tips and freshly mown lawns.





THE IDEA OF FORMING A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN DOMAINES BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE AND THE PRESTIGIOUS ARGENTINIAN WINE FAMILY CATENA WAS BORN IN 1999. INITIAL ENTHUSIASM QUICKLY BECAME A CONCRETE PLAN TO PRODUCE A SINGLE WINE THAT WOULD COMBINE FRENCH AND ARGENTINE CULTURES AND ENHANCE THE ALLIANCE BETWEEN THE SIGNATURE GRAPE OF EACH PRODUCER, MALBEC AND CABERNET SAUVIGNON.

Work began in 1999 to produce Bodegas CARO's first vintage in 2000. The success of the early vintages resulted in the creation of another wine in 2003, AMANCAYA, which similarly to its older brother is based on a harmonious balance of Argentinian identity and Bordeaux style. Bodegas CARO later decided to celebrate the grape variety for which Argentina's vineyards are famous by launching a pure Malbec, ARUMA, in 2010.

The most recent addition to the esteemed portfolio has been Petit Caro. Working with a similar blend to Amancaya, sourced from only the best plots and given extra time in oak for a beautiful smokey depth of flavour. The Bodegas CARO winery, set in the heart of Mendoza, has been producing the wines since the 2003 vintage and serves as the anchor of the CARO project. The renovation of the historic building and gardens in order to expand the winery and open the Bodega to the outside has brought the final touch to the original project.

WHEN BARON NATHANIEL ACQUIRED CHÂTEAU MOUTON ROTHSCHILD AT AUCTION IN 1853, LITTLE DID HE KNOW THAT HE HELD IN HIS HANDS THE KEYS TO THE START OF ONE OF THE WORLD'S MOST RESPECTED BORDEAUX WINE BRANDS

Founded 80 years later in 1933, the Baron Philippe de Rothschild Group today manages an exquisite roster of estates and branded wines that expand far beyond its Bordeaux heart, maintaining the same dedication to excellence that has characterised the family's winemaking style for generations.

The Group's activities in Bordeaux comprise three Classified Growths in the Pauillac appellation, Château d'Armailhac (1933), Château Clerc Milon (1970) and of course the illustrious Château Mouton Rothschild. In addition they offer a range of high quality branded wines that are sourced from various partner growers and then blended, matured and bottled by the Group itself, foremost among them the famous Mouton Cadet. Expansions have continued in France to the Pays d'Oc at Domaine de Baronarques (1998), and across the Atlantic with two pioneering family partnerships; one with the Mondavi family and the establishment of Opus One Winery (1979) in the USA and another with Concha y Toro in Chile with the formation of Viña Almaviva (1997), in addition to other branded Chilean wines Escudo Rojo and Mas Andes.

It is a unique blend of respect for traditional know-how and adaptability that have ensured the continued quality and prestige of the Group's wines. To this day it remains an entirely family affair, run by three siblings Camille Sereys de Rothschild, Philippe Sereys de Rothschild and Julien de Beaumarchais de Rothschild.





IN 1922 THE 20-YEAR-OLD BARON PHILIPPE DE ROTHSCHILD, YOUNGEST SON OF BARON HENRI AND GREAT-GRANDSON OF CHÂTEAU MOUTON'S ORIGINAL BUYER, BARON NATHANIEL, TOOK THE DESTINY OF THE ESTATE IN HAND. DURING HIS REIGN WHICH SPANNED MORE THAN 60 YEARS, HIS DECISIONS WOULD PROFOUNDLY CHANGE THE WORLD OF WINE, RAISE THE IMAGE OF THE FAMILY CHÂTEAU TO UNPARALLELED HEIGHTS AND CONSIDERABLY INCREASE THE RANGE AND GEOGRAPHICAL SCOPE OF ITS ACTIVITIES.

Baron Philippe de Rothschild had the bold idea of making the wealth of the Bordeaux terroir accessible to a wider public and in 1930 Mouton Cadet was born, with a nod to Baron Philippe's position as the younger son (cadet in French) of the family. Renewal and innovation have been a constant feature of the celebrated Bordeaux brand ever since its creation, and huge worldwide expansion under the guidance of Baron Philippe's daughter, Baroness Philippine de Rothschild, sealed its international reputation.

Now the third generation, siblings Philippe Sereys de Rothschild, Camille Sereys de Rothschild and Julien de Beaumarchais de Rothschild, is motivated by the same ambition: to take Mouton Cadet higher and further. Today all Mouton Cadet wines are matured, blended, bottled and stored at the Mouton Cadet Winery in Saint-Laurent-Médoc. The new Mouton Cadet reds are now matured for 18 months in a process which brings toasted notes and makes the tannins rounder and more supple while preserving their characteristic fruit. Mouton Cadet white and Mouton Cadet Sauvignon Blanc are matured for at least four months, as is also the case for Mouton Cadet rosé.





Rosé.....**6 x 75cl** A light and elegant rosé blend, with raspberry and watermelon notes. Perfect summer drinking.

Sauvignon Blanc.....**6 x 75cl** A bright and elegant Sauvignon Blanc with perfect acidity and citrus, apple and pear flavours.

1930s Label6 x 75cl The original 1930s label on this globally iconic Cabernet and Merlot blend with elegant oak influences, delivering everyday drinking Bordeaux to please even the most discerning of palates.

Réserve Rouge.....**6 x 75cl** Additional oak ageing and greater selection produces a wine that has additional depth and sophistaction, for drinking now or keeping for 2-5 years.

Réserve Graves Blanc.....**6 x 75cl** A delicious blend of Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc and a touch of Muscadelle, this wine gives all the characteristic unique minerality of the Graves terroir.

Réserve St.Émilion.....6 x 75cl Predominantly sourced from the clay-rich soils of Saint-Émilion, this is a Merlot-dominated wine that is aged for 16 months to create a typically rich and spicy style in keeping with this appellation.

Réserve Sauternes......6 x 75cl Situated 40 km south-east of Bordeaux, the Sauternes appellation is famous throughout the world for its sweet white wines. Reserve Mouton Cadet produces a deliciously fresh style of Sauternes to be consumed whilst young.





THIS COLLECTION OF VARIETAL WINES FROM THE PAYS D'OC OFFERS A WHOLE PALETTE OF FLAVOURS, SHOWCASING THE DIVERSITY OF TERROIRS ASSOCIATED WITH THE WINES OF BARON PHILIPPE DE ROTHSCHILD.

The fruit of the bright Languedoc sun, this range comprises three white and four red wines, each one representative of a different grape varietal: Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Viognier, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Syrah and Merlot. These fruity wines form the ideal accompaniment to food and can be enjoyed at any time of year or occasion, though they lend themselves particularly well to summer drinking.





Sauvignon Blanc.....**6 x 75cl** This Sauvignon Blanc is dry, crisp and fresh, with subtle citrus fruit and floral aromas.

of exceptional quality, full bodied but delicately fragrant.

Cabernet Sauvignon.....6 x 75cl From the region around Limoux the highest quality parcels of Cabernet Sauvognon are selected to produce a wine full of black fruit aromas, followed by mild spice notes and a touch of freshness.

Pinot Noir.....6 x 75cl In the heart of Languedoc-Roussillon, Baron Philippe de Rothschild's winemakers have selected the areas with the best soil and climate for growing the Pinot Noir grape. **Syrah**.....**6 x 75cl** This wine displays a wonderful bouquet of herby garrigue and ripe black fruit, especially blackberry and blackcurrant.

These fine branded wines are both cultivated in the great Bordeaux winemaking tradition of Baron Philippe de Rothschild and capitalise on Chile's environmental richness.

Just four years after the launch of Escudo Rojo, Baroness Philippine de Rothschild inaugurated the Baron Philippe de Rothschild Maipo Chile Bodega in 2003, situated 45 kilometres south of Santiago in the Maipo Valley. The opening marked Baron Philippe de Rothschild's deep commitment to Chile. Today not only Escudo Rojo but also the Anderra and Mas Andes wines are all made, matured and bottled on site at the Maipo Chile Bodega to ensure their high quality is maintained. The Baron Philippe de Rothschild's spirit permeates the production of their Chilean wines through the quest for high quality. Escudo Rojo blends Chilean identity with French style. Fruity and flavourful with soft tannins, these wines are designed to be enjoyed and shared.

JAMES DE ROTHSCHILD'S GREAT-GRANDSON, EDMOND DE ROTHSCHILD, BEGAN A NEW CHAPTER IN THE FAMILY WINEGROWING ADVENTURE IN 1973 BY ACQUIRING TWO CRUS BOURGEOIS ESTATES IN THE LISTRAC AND MOULIS-EN-MÉDOC APPELLATIONS OF BORDEAUX: CHÂTEAU CLARKE AND CHÂTEAU MALMAISON.

And so The Compagnie Vinicole Baron Edmond de Rothschild was born. In 1997, Benjamin and Ariane de Rothschild gave a dramatic boost to the Compagnie Vinicole by exploring new terroirs around the globe. Determined to apply traditional French expertise while maintaining local winegrowing practices, they created jointventures with families that possessed the same entrepreneurial spirit and love of wine, first in South Africa, then in Argentina and finally New Zealand. Vines planted around the world in virgin lands are now the source of internationally renowned, high quality wines.





ELEGANT, FINE, AND DENSE, EMBODYING THE TYPICAL CHARACTER OF ITS TERROIR, CHÂTEAU CLARKE IS CONSIDERED ONE OF THE MOST PROMISING WINES IN THE MÉDOC. TODAY'S FOCUS ON EXCELLENCE AIMS TO BRING OUT ITS FULL POTENTIAL, BOTH IN THE VINEYARD AND IN THE CELLAR, AND TO ELEVATE CHÂTEAU CLARKE TO RANK AMONG THE GREATEST MÉDOC WINES.

The estate is in the southern part of the Médoc within the Listrac-Médoc appellation. Its inland location is far from the Gironde estuary in the middle of the limestone plateau and a distinctive feature of the estate's clay-limestone soil is its remarkable drought resistance.

The proximity of the Atlantic Ocean gives a cool freshness that is echoed in the wine's bright bouquet. Though Cabernet Sauvignon is traditionally king of the region, the Château's terroir is very well suited to growing Merlot and this varietal accounts for 70% of the estate's production. Thus, Château Clarke is typical of the Médoc, but in an entirely original way. Sauvignon Blanc, Sauvignon Gris, Muscadelle and Sémillon, which are used in the Le Merle Blanc blend, occupy a small, three-hectare space for limited production.

The first wine of Edmond de Rothschild, Château Clarke epitomises the attention to detail shown in all they do. Merlot-led, the silky tannins, perfect structure and decadent complexity make this a must-try Bordeaux.

Château Clarke is one of the rare Médoc estates to create a white wine. Part of the Château's heritage since 1890, Le Merle Blanc translates to mean 'The White Blackbird', denoting its scaricty and intrigue. A complex and inviting blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Sauvignon Gris, Muscadelle and Sémillon. A delicate and precise wine with flavours of peach and exotic fruits, full body and fantastic length.







CHÂTEAU MALMAISON, IN THE MOULIS-EN-MÉDOC APPELLATION, IS ONE OF THE OLDEST ESTATES IN THE MÉDOC. GRAPES HAVE BEEN GROWN HERE, THANKS TO A HANDFUL OF DIFFERENT OWNERS AND A SIZEABLE RELIGIOUS COMMUNITY, EVER SINCE THE MIDDLE AGES.

This property, which adjoins Château Clarke, was purchased by Baron de Rothschild in 1973. Thanks to his impetus, the vineyard was restored to its former glory. He named the wine after his spouse, the Baroness Nadine de Rothschild, a passionate gardener. The vineyard now covers 33 hectares of clay-limestone soil, which is ideal for Merlot, the predominant grape variety. Château Malmaison allies delicacy, suppleness and elegance with a rich and fruity bouquet.

THE PLOTS OF CHÂTEAU DES LAURETS STRADDLE TWO APPELLATIONS: PUISSEGUIN SAINT-ÉMILION AND MONTAGNE SAINT-ÉMILION.

The vineyards surrounding the Château and the estate's slope receive optimal southern exposure. The clay-limestone terroir is naturally ideal for growing Merlot, the reigning grape of Saint-Émilion, for this soil profile enables the variety to achieve its full power and signature qualities. Black grape varieties are grown on all the plots.

Of the 95 hectares that make up the property, 36 hectares are reserved to produce Château des Laurets, a blend that is primarily Merlot complemented by Cabernet Franc. Another four hectares were chosen from the best Merlot plots to produce a wine that epitomizes the property. Ever since his purchase of Château des Laurets, Benjamin de Rothschild wished to reveal the quintessence of this estate by making a special cuvée, and so, Château des Laurets Baron was created. This wine remained a family secret until 2015, when it was revealed for the very first time.

BORN OUT OF BENJAMIN DE ROTHSCHILD'S DESIRE TO CREATE A LEADING SAUVIGNON BLANC, THE RIMAPERE ESTATE IN MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND WAS CHOSEN FOR ITS EXCEPTIONAL TERROIR AND CLIMATE. THE NAME OF THE PROPERTY WAS A DELIBERATE CHOICE: IT MEANS "FIVE ARROWS" IN MAORI AND SIMULTANEOUSLY HONORS THE ROTHSCHILD FAMILY'S EMBLEM AND TRADITIONAL NEW ZEALAND CULTURE.

Rimapere enjoys an incredible terroir. The vineyard comprises 24 hectares of vines that are ideally situated on the prestigious Rapaura site, known as the 'Golden Triangle', where the alluvial soil comprises mainly pebbles and gravel. Sauvignon Blanc is grown on 20 hectares and 4 hectares are kept aside for the cultivation of Pinot Noir. The vineyard is sustainably farmed, with an average age of around 15 years. This area's cool climate is perfect for ripening high quality Sauvignon Blanc grapes and providing them with their typical lemon and grapefruit flavors, together with crisp acidity.





Rimapere Sauvignon Blanc.....**6 x 75cl** Aromas of citrus fruits, green tea and blackcurrant bush lead

to ripe lemon and gooseberry notes and a long, texturally dry finish. Youthful and salivating, a Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with an unmistakable French elegance.

Complex, spicy aromatics of black cherry, baking spices and a hint of dried pine needles. Well integrated fine oak creates a lovely structure and perfectly balanced finish.





FLECHAS DE LOS ANDES IS THE RESULT OF AN ALLIANCE BETWEEN BARON BENJAMIN DE ROTHSCHILD AND MONSIEUR LAURENT DASSAULT, REFLECTING THE FULFILMENT OF THEIR QUEST TO FIND A GREAT TERROIR AT THE BASE OF THE ANDES. LOCATED 120 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF MENDOZA, ARGENTINA, NEAR THE VILLAGE OF VISTA FLORES, THE FLECHAS DE LOS ANDES VINEYARD NOW OCCUPIES MORE THAN 100 HECTARES IN THE ANDES FOOTHILLS. THE FIRST VINES WERE PLANTED IN 1999 AND ARE QUITE DENSE FOR ARGENTINA (5,500 VINES PER HECTARE).

The Malbec grapes thrive on these ideal plots of rocks, granite pebbles and alluvial gravels perched at 1,100 meters above sea level. They are joined by plots of Merlot, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon.

The hot, dry climate is characterized as semiarid continental and features pronounced temperature fluctuations between day and night and across seasons. These midaltitude conditions are highly conducive to the ripening of black grapes and, more particularly, of Malbec.





FLECHAS DE LOS ANDES

Made from a selection of Malbec grapes grown at 335 metres above sea level in the foothills of the Andes. One-third of the wine was aged for 10 months in oak barrels.

Gran Malbec......6 x 75cl

100% Malbec aged in new French oak for 18 months. Gran Malbec is a robust and intense wine with flavours of succulent dark berry fruits, coffee and finishing on white pepper.

Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Syrah aged in new French oak for 24 months combine to create a complex and powerful wine. Deep plum and blueberry notes are complemented by smokey tannins and a lingering spicy finish.







The Rupert & Rothschild wine-growing region sits amongst the northernmost vineyards of the southern hemisphere, and the vines they cultivate here extend over more than 100 hectares. The partnership's estate in Fredericksburg, an historic French Huguenot farm established in 1690, lies at the foot of the spectacular Simonsberg mountain in the Franschhoek Valley between Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschhoek.

The deal struck between Dr Anton Rupert and Baron Edmond de Rothschild in 1997 has continued to be passed down the generations, with both men relinquishing the reigns to their respective sons: Anthonij Rupert and Baron Benjamin de Rothschild. Following the passing of Anthonij Rupert in 2001, his older brother Johann Rupert and sister Hanneli Rupert-Koegelenberg assumed his position. Rupert & Rothschild produce three distinct wines; a single varietal Chardonnay; Rupert & Rothschild Baroness Nadine, named after the wife of Baron Edmond; a flagship Bordeaux blend; Rupert & Rothschild Baron Edmond and a classic red blend; Rupert & Rothschild Classique, one of South Africa's most sought after red blends.

Today, Rupert & Rothschild Vignerons is an internationally recognised premier wine brand. A luxuriously elegant and classical brand that underpins a winemaking philosophy of excellence and craftsmanship.



Exacting and unrelenting in his passions, for Woodbridge there is no halfway. And it is only once you truly grasp that concept that you begin to understand how Hundred Acre has become one of the world's top wineries. The awarding of 22 perfect 100 scores to Hundred Acre wines by Robert Parker's Wine Advocate since 2002 speaks for itself. As Lisa Perrotti-Brown states, Hundred Acre is "far from a vanity wine project, it's a life's work".

Woodbridge's unique approach sees him intimately involved in each step of the grapegrowing and winemaking process, from hand-picking in numerous passes, handsorting berry by berry, to carefully selecting the forest and age of barrels used.

Everything is hand-crafted, hand-pruned, scrutinized and aligned for his desired response. Each Cabernet Sauvignon represents three single estate vineyards from Napa Valley, named after Woodbridge's three children: Kayli Morgan, ARK and Few and Far Between.

A plethora of distinct blends and differentlyaged lots also make up the Hundred Acre portfolio, such as Wraith, a 'Holy Trinity' blend of Kayli Morgan, ARK and Few and Far Between, and Deep Time, a study in how oak integrates over time and how Cabernet Sauvignon can continue to concentrate over five or more years.

ARK is comprised of nine different blocks of Cabernet Sauvignon, planted meter by meter in nine different volcanic soil strata. The vineyard stretches through a sixty-millionyear time sequence: three ancient beach fronts, a prehistoric weapons quarry, and spans a 180-degree arc of the sun over its half-mile length.

Ark Deep Time£POA

Hundred Acre Deep Time wines are aged for a minimum of 36 months in the finest French oak barriques. The stave wood is hand-selected for ultra-tight grain, then air dried for three years before being made into barrels.

Kayli Morgan Vineyard.....£POA

The Kayli Morgan Vineyard is a single estate vineyard located just north of Saint Helena, California at the base of Howell Mountain and planted with 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. The soils are a chocolatey clay, holding moisture to keep the vines cool. As summer progresses, the ground forms micro-cracks, allowing the roots to seek water deeper and deeper into the earth; as they do, they pick up minerals that give Kayli Morgan its distinctive characteristics.

All the same wonders of the Kayli Morgan Vineyard, with an extra year in those amazing oak barrels.

Few & Far Between Vineyard £POA

Few and Far Between is one of three estate vineyards, all of which are farmed organically although they are not certified. The 5-acre Few and Far Between is tucked deep in a small valley in Calistoga. Just down a gentle slope is historic Eisele Vineyard, best known as the source of Araujo Estate's Cabernet Sauvignon and considered hallowed ground by many. The pristine site, planted in rocky alluvial soils, is 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and the rest Cabernet Franc.

Wraith.....£POA

Wraith is a trinity of Hundred Acre's three single vineyard wines. It is a selection of barrels set aside in the cellar from those waiting to be blended someday into the single vineyard wines from Kayli Morgan, ARK or Few and Far Between. All very different and incredibly unique. The Wraith shows all the beauty and personality of each individual vineyard and how they come together to develop even greater complexity.

NESTLED IN A COASTAL BAY IN PROVENCE, JUST A STONE'S THROW FROM ST. TROPEZ, LIES THE LÉOUBE ESTATE, ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL PROTECTED SITES IN EUROPE AND HOME TO CHÂTEAU LÉOUBE.

Spread across four kilometres of coastline, the estate includes 65 hectares of vineyards and 20 hectares of olive groves, all devoted to growing the grapes and olives that make Léoube's certified organic wines and olive oils

Provence is home to some of the oldest vineyards in France, with soils dating back over 800 million years. To maintain the heritage of the land, Château Léoube believes in time-honoured, artisan farming, following biodynamic principles. Guided by head wine maker Romain Ott, this is what they have strived to make reality.

All grapes are harvested and sorted by hand, in tune with the seasonal and lunar cycles. It is believed that if the balance of the plant is respected, then it will produce only the most balanced fruit in return. The flourishing of the vines and olive trees at Léoube bear testimony to the wisdom of this natural approach. In the cellar, only whole clusters of grapes are used and crushed by direct pressing. The wines are fermented with indigenous yeasts and also undergo malolactic fermentation, with little-to-no use of sulphites. The Château's rosés undergo at least six months on the lees, to allow complex flavours and textures to develop and resulting in wines that are well balanced, fresh, and full of character, whilst remaining true to their terroir.





Love by Léoube.....**6 x 75cl** A harmonious blend of Grenache and Cinsault, Love is a quintessential, dry Provence rosé style. Pale Pink with attractive fruit flavours of strawberry and white peach and fine overall balance.

Le Secret de Léoube**6 x 75cl** Made from lower yields, Secret is delicately scented, distinctly pale and carries the most elegant of pear aromas. Assured and effortless, Secret is remarkable for its texture and sensation in the mouth.

Les Forts de Léoube**6 x 75cl** Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault and Cabernet Sauvignon combine here to produce youthful flavours of plum and cherry, developing into more complex notes of walnut, dried fruits and tobacco.

Sparkling de Léoube**6 x 75cl** Very few sparkling rosés are made in Provence, so this is rather special. Showing just the barest blush of pink, it is equally subtle on the nose and palate. With delicate tones of hazelnut and soft fruit, it is unusually dry for a sparkling wine.

CHÂTEAU D'ANGLÈS

LA CLAPE BECAME THE LANGUEDOC'S FIRST 'APPELLATION COMMUNALE' IN JUNE 2015, A SUCCESS STORY THAT CONSTITUTES BUT A RECENT CHAPTER IN THE REGION'S RICH, 2,000-YEAR-OLD WINEMAKING HISTORY.

Julius Cesar gifted this rocky outcrop overlooking the Mediterranean to his most favoured legionnaires, and so it was the soldiers of the 10th legion who first began the planting of the hallowed Bourboulenc grape variety there, considered in Greek mythology to confer wisdom on those who drank it.

More than a thousand years later, the Languedoc was brought under the rule of the French King Louis VIII and governed by the Baillys d'Anglès from 1226. In the following centuries the property endured Revolution, division and the passing from owner to owner until the Fabre family were finally able to reunite Château d'Anglès under its original family name at the beginning of the 21st century. The vines at Château d'Anglès enjoy a unique combination of natural elements; basked in sunshine for 300 days a year, refreshed by the Mediterranean breeze, deeply rooted in the hostile rocky, limestone soils and enveloped in the surrounding aromatic vegetation known as 'garrigue'. This exceptional terroir expresses its very best under the watchful eye of Eric Fabre, whose talent and experience permeate each stage of the winemaking process, from hand-picking and careful selection, to patient nursing in French oak barrels and painstaking blending.

The resulting wines are a perfect harmony of mature and fresh, generous and precise, powerful and structured... testament to the reputation of Château d'Anglès, which is lauded by the international press, experts and wine lovers across the globe.



CHÂTEAU D'ANGLÈS

Mourvèdre, Syrah and Grenache come together to create a brilliant, pink flamingo colour. Intense and complex nose of white flowers and citrus fruits. Plentiful mouth with a long and complex aromatic composition balanced by a mineral freshness.

Bourboulenc, Grenache, Roussanne and Marsanne aged on its lees in concrete. An elegant bouquet of spring flowers and fresh spices, a smooth mouth revealing a rich and long complexity of white fruits with elegant minerality.

Syrah, Grenache and Mourvèdre, the aroma here evokes ripe red and black fruits, white pepper and liquorice. A smooth, fruity and balanced wine, structured by delicate and silky tannins.

Bourboulenc, Grenache, Roussanne and Marsanne come together with a rich and complex nose, a blend of white fruits and flowers, fresh and sweet spices, honey and nuts. Oak aged on its lees for added complexity.

Mourvèdre, Syrah, Grenache and Carignan with 10 months of oak age. Deep red colour with hints of black, a complex bouquet with a blend of ripe red and black fruits, spices, licorice and tobacco flavours hilghlighted by the typical minty touch of La Clape.

Luce.....**6 x 75cl OWC** The first wine of the estate, a blend of Merlot and Sangiovese aged for 24 months in oak barriques. This wine possesses a rich, deep colour accompanied by an aromatic bouquet of fresh fruit and a smoothness distinguished by elegant and pleasant tannins.

Of the 88 hectares of vineyards owned by Luce della Vite, 11 are registered in the Albo del Brunello di Montalcino and used to produce this award-winning Brunello of the highest quality.

Lucente....**6 x 75cl** Lucente is Luce's second wine, the result of a selection of Sangiovese and Merlot grapes capable of producing a wine that stands out thanks to its immediacy and pleasantness, in a contemporary style. It is the perfect representation of the unique territory where it is produced.





ATTEMS IS A NAME THAT ENCOMPASSES THE HISTORY OF WINE IN FRIULI VENEZIA GIULIA. THERE IS DOCUMENTATION THAT CONFIRMS OWNERSHIP OF LAND DEDICATED TO VITICULTURE IN COLLIO BY THE ATTEMS DYNASTY DATING AS FAR BACK AS 1106, AND A LISTING IN THE GENERAL LEDGERS FOR THE PRODUCTION OF NATIVE GRAPE VARIETALS RIBOLLA GIALLA AND REFOSCO SINCE 1764.

The story of Attems is thus interwoven with history: from the Patriarchate of Aquileia to the County of Gorizia, from the First World War to the present day. Since the year 2000, Attems has been the property of the Frescobaldi family who continue to preserve its distinctive and traditional character with the utmost respect. The estate extends over 44 hectares of southfacing terraced slopes to the west of Gorizia, protected both from the cold northern winds and the 'bora' wind of Trieste. The vineyards flourish in these idyllic environmental conditions and yield fruits of superb calibre, not only from native but also other noble varietals including Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Grigio, Chardonnay and Merlot.

Expert care is lavished on it by those with centuries-old knowledge of this terroir, to create Cicinis, Attems' iconic wine.

Lucia's blended passion for both dance and wine is in perfect harmony with the Danzante collection, an expression of the pure Italian passion for life.





Prosecco -6 x 75cl This extra dry sparkling wine wine shows all the freshness and character of the soils it hails from with an intensely fruity bouquet and a pleasantly fresh, balanced finish.

Produced from Sangiovese grapes that originate in the hills between the Provinces of Siena and Florence, this is a Chianti that has spicy nuances of roasted espresso bean, notes of vanilla, and black liquorice.
